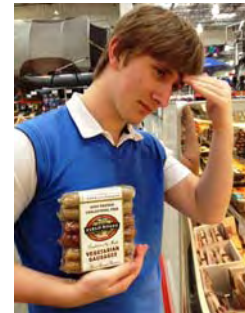

Member Profile: Rosemary Hagevig, Past President

Rosemary is a 16-year member of the Juneau Gastineau Rotary Club and served as club president for 2008-2009. She was honored to be named Juneau's Citizen of the Year in 1995, and was one of 11 Alaskans selected to carry the Olympic Torch in 1996.

Rosemary is retiring from her post as executive director of Catholic Community Services, which she has managed since December 1998. CCS has over 250 employees and a budget of over \$10 million, with three divisions: Southeast Senior Services, Hospice and Home Health Care of Juneau, and Child Care and Family Resources. She was on the Board of Directors for CCS from 1990 to 1998. Her plethora of experience also includes:

Southeast Conference: Served on the Board of Directors for 10 years and as conference president from 2000-2001.

City and Borough of Juneau: Appointed to the Planning Commission 1992-1993, and served two terms as Assembly member beginning in 1994.

Alaska Municipal League: Served 5 years on the Board of Directors, as State president from 1996-1998. Served on national committees as a representative of AML.

League of Women Voters: From 1967-1991, in both Ketchikan and Juneau, served on the Board of Directors and other statewide organizations. Served terms as president of the LWV of Juneau and LWV of Alaska.

Catholic Charities USA: Served several terms on the Agency Directors Steering Committee beginning in 2005 to present.


Child Welfare League of America: Western States Steering Committee from 2009 to present.

AARP Alaska: State Executive Council; State President 2007 to present.

State of Alaska, Department of Education: For 27.5 years, employed in several capacities including Accounting, Human Resources, and Program Administrator, retiring in June 1997. Served 10 years as executive staff to the State Board of Education.

Rosemary is a widow—married for 30 years to Bill Hagevig, originally of Ketchikan. She was born and raised in Seattle and moved to Alaska in 1962 when she married Bill. Rosemary has three adult children and is the proud grandmother of five amazing grandchildren.
